Weather Discussion:

The chance of showers increases from Wednesday night into the weekend as Tropical Storm Bret dominates the weather pattern across Saint Vincent and the Grenadines. Scattered showers ahead of the storm is expected, increasing in intensity around Thursday night into Friday. Model guidance is indicating roughly 1 inch (25mm) by early Thursday night, and a further 2-3 inches (50mm-75m) from Friday into Saturday. These showers can be accompanied by isolated thunderstorms. Strong winds are forecast throughout the period, with winds blowing initially from the ENE at 20km/h-40km/h with higher gust near showers, then becoming ESE around Friday into Saturday.

Seas will gradually deteriorate and become generally rough (3.5m). A marine advisory will be issued.

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
