Weather Discussion:

A film/slight-haze across our area clears-out this evening and moisture levels are expected to increase across St.Vincent and the Grenadines (SVG) overnight. Occasionally cloudy skies with scattered showers can be expected tonight and during Saturday, breaking dry-spells/episodes across our islands. Weak unstable conditions could linger across SVG for a few days, with light-moderate showers.

Moderate-fresh (25 - 35km/h) north-easterlies temporarily decrease (~20km/h) during Sunday, with directions varying east north-easterly to east south-easterly.

Sea conditions are moderate in open water, with swells ranging 1.0m - 1.8m west of our islands and 1.8m - 2.5m east of our islands...*Small craft operators and sea bathers should continue to exercise caution for above normal swells and occasional gusty winds...Swell heights peak Saturday and start falling Sunday morning, with slight to moderate (1.0m - 2.0m) sea conditions across our islands.*
