Weather Discussion:

The Atlantic high pressure system will continue to dominate the weather pattern during the next few days pumping fresh breeze across the islands. Generally, fair conditions are expected with a slight chance of isolated passing showers within the next 3 days.

Moderate to fresh (25-35km/h) easterly to east south easterly trades are currently crossing the islands. Wind speeds will slightly decrease (~30km/h) from Tuesday and shift to east north easterly and become gentle (<20km/h) on Thursday. Moderate sea conditions are expected to continue with swells ranging between 1.5m-2.0m. **Small craft operators and sea bathers should continue to exercise caution.** Swell heights could begin to fall around Wednesday night with improvements on Thursday as wind speeds decrease. No significant haze intrusion is expected within this forecast period.
