Weather Discussion:

Due to the emergence of a relatively dry and stable atmospheric environment, the likelihood of showers decreases within the next 24 hours. Model guidance suggests that this chance increases on Wednesday and Thursday.

Moderate to fresh (25-35km/h) easterly to east north easterly trades will cross the islands within this forecast period, decreasing (20-30km/h) from Tuesday. Seas are currently moderate in open water but could improve around Wednesday. **Small craft operators and sea bathers should exercise caution for above normal sea swells and occasional gusty winds.** In addition, Saharan dust haze concentrations are thinning out gradually but could return by late Wednesday.
