Weather Discussion:

Saharan dust haze concentrations will vary in intensity during the next 3 days reducing air quality and visibility...Remain Alert! The chance of showers increases early Monday but decreases by evening. Relatively fair conditions are anticipated from then on up to midweek as the Atlantic high pressure system is expected to dominate.

Moderate to fresh (~20-35km/h) east north easterly trades will continue to cross the islands before becoming easterly to east south easterly from Monday. Sea conditions are moderate in open waters and would become moderate to rough along Monday and Tuesday with swells ranging between 1.5m and 2.0m on western coasts and between 1.8m to 2.7m on eastern coasts. Northerly long period swells are also affecting our northern and eastern coasts allowing for dangerous rip currents and breaking wake action near the shoreline. Therefore, **small craft operators and sea-bathers should be prepared.** These conditions will affect our marine area over the next few days.

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
