PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENT

The National Emergency Management Organisation (NEMO) invite residents of Colonaire and surrounding areas to a meeting on Tuesday 22nd August, 2023 at the George Stephens (Senior) Secondary School beginning at 5:30 p.m. This meeting will be held in collaboration with the Caribbean Disaster Emergency Management Agency (CDEMA) Coordinating Unit and the University of the West Indies.

The purpose of the meeting is to discuss the implementation of the Caribbean Community Risk Information Tool (CCRIT) in Colonaire which is identified as one of the three most vulnerable communities based on the application of the tool in Saint Vincent and the Grenadines. The CCRIT is a community-based data collection tool that uses quantitative geospatial data and qualitative community socio-demographic data. It facilitates the identification of potential hazards and associated socio-economic vulnerabilities that can affect the respective communities.

Residents of Colonaire and surrounding areas are asked to make a special effort to attend this community meeting on Tuesday 22nd August, 2023 at the George Stephens (Senior) Secondary School beginning at 5:30 p.m.
