1. Testing and preparation to install a permanent multi-gas monitoring instrument at the top the volcano continues.
2. Training of local volunteers in seismic data processing continued today.
3. Professor Richard Robertson, Geologist, Seismic Research Centre will re-join the team on Monday 15th March, 2021.
4. The team from the Soufriere Monitoring Unit will conduct a drone survey and take aerial photographs of the volcano on Saturday 13th March, 2020, once the weather condition is good.
5. The National Emergency Management Organisation is reminding the public that no evacuation order or notice has been issued.
6. NEMO continues to appeal to the public to desist from visiting the La Soufrière Volcano, especially going into the crater, since doing so is extremely dangerous.
7. NEMO will continue to provide regular updates on all activities taking place at La Soufrière.
