Weather Discussion:

As a low-level trough along with a favourable upper level continue to dominate the weather pattern across the region, a similar weather pattern to what has been taking place over the last few days (fair conditions alternating with cloudy spells and showers), are anticipated across SVG for the upcoming 3 days, with the highest chance of moderate showers forecast for Saturday, December 14th.

Gentle to moderate winds will blow from the north east to east south east (NE-ESE) at (5km/h-25km/h). Seas will be slight to moderate in open waters, with swells peaking at 1.0m on the western coasts and 1.5m on the eastern coasts. There will be slight haze intrusion within the forecast period.
