Weather Discussion:

A few showers are expected across St. Vincent and the Grenadines (SVG) tonight, as a tropical wave crosses the islands. Lower-level clouds converging across our islands during Friday, could maintain scattered light-moderate showers with isolated thunderstorms. Showers and thunderstorm activity could peak by evening into night, with a few showers lingering on Saturday. Fair to partly cloudy skies could bring isolated showers on Sunday. Varying concentrations of Saharan dust occasionally create thin film/slight haze across our area.

Gentle to moderate (15 - 25km/h) breeze could occasionally increase near 30km/h and vary in direction between east north-east and east south-east.

Marine conditions are slight, across SVG with swells ranging 0.5m to 1.0m and gently rising to near 1.5m on eastern coasts of our islands during Sunday with slight to moderate conditions.
