## **Weather Discussion:**

A few brief showers are likely today, to the north of the mainland as a weak low-level trough moves across the islands. Mostly partly cloudy skies with a low chance of showers are anticipated elsewhere up to Friday morning. A tropical wave inches closer to the island chain, and this could result in an increase in cloud cover along Friday into Saturday, with chance of scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms. The latter part of Saturday should have mostly fair conditions.

Moderate easterly trades (15km/h-30km/h) will move across the islands, becoming east northeast (ENE) ahead the wave around Friday, and east south-east (ESE) behind the wave on Saturday. Seas will remain slight to moderate in open waters with swells ranging between 1.0m - 2.0m. There will be slight haze intrusion within this forecast period.

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
