Weather Discussion:

The chance of showers increases from late Wednesday night, and will remain high as a low level trough moves across the island chain.

Moderate winds (15 km/h-30 km/h) will blow generally from the east (E), backing to east northeast (ENE) on occasions, and veering to east southeast (ESE) around Friday. Seas will be moderate in open waters with swells peaking at 1.5m on the western coasts and 2.0m on the eastern coasts. In addition, slight haze intrusion is forecast within this forecast period.

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
