Weather Discussion:

Weak unstable conditions linger across our islands allowing for cloudy skies and occasional isolated showers for the remainder of Sunday. Over the next few days a few intermittent showers are likely as a ridge pattern becomes dominant. In addition, breezy conditions can be expected during this forecast period.

Moderate to fresh (~20-35km/h) east south-easterly trades are currently crossing our islands. Increased wind speeds (~40 km/h) are expected on Tuesday. Seas will be moderate in open water ranging between 1.5m to 2.5m. **Small craft operators and sea bathers should exercise extreme caution for above normal sea swells.** Saharan dust haze concentrations should be noticeable across our area from Tuesday.
