Weather Discussion:

A ridge pattern is dominant across the islands, allowing for fair and warm conditions with brief light isolated showers along Friday afternoon. Over the weekend, warm conditions will persist with the possibility of isolated showers. Unstable conditions are likely to affect the islands along Monday afternoon.

Gentle to moderate (15-25km/h) south easterly to east south easterly trades are crossing our islands. On Monday, a slight increase (~15-30km/h) is expected. Seas are forecast to be smooth to slight in open waters with swells peaking to 0.5m on the western coasts, and up to 1.2m on the eastern coasts. There will be no significant haze intrusion within this forecast period.
