Weather Discussion:

Tonight, the chance of showers remains high across Saint Vincent and the Grenadines as low to mid-levels remain moist. The chance of showers will decrease, but remains possible during the next 3 days as the Atlantic high pressure system regains dominance across the island chain.

Winds will blow generally from the east south-east (ESE), backing to east (E) on occasions at 10 km/h-25km/h. Seas are forecast to be slight to moderate with swells peaking at 1.0m on the western coasts and 1.5m on the eastern coasts. There will be no haze intrusion during the next two days, but slight intrusion is expected on Sunday.
