## Weather Discussion:

The tail end of a tropical wave is affecting SVG. Pockets of light to moderate showers, periods of light rain and thunderstorm activity is expected to persist across SVG on Wednesday afternoon. A flash flood watch remains in effect for SVG until 6pm today. Residents and motorists in areas prone to flooding and landslides or near rivers and streams should be prepared. Conditions could improve from Thursday afternoon until around mid Saturday when another tropical wave is expected to affect our islands.

Gentle to fresh(15-30km/h)east south easterly trades could turn ENE late Wednesday before reverting on Thursday and increasing to occasionally(near 40 km/h).

Marine conditions would be slight to moderate ranging between (0.5m to 2.2m/1.6ft to 7ft) across the next 3 days

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
