Weather Discussion:

The recent and relatively fair conditions could be interrupted on Wednesday as unstable conditions increases the chance of showers. Similar conditions are likely early Thursday before a ridge pattern rebuilds and allow for fairer conditions into Friday.

Gentle to moderate (15-25km/h) east south easterly trades will cross the islands within the next 24 hours but winds speeds will continue to increase (>30km/h) from Thursday. Seas are forecast to be slight to moderate with swells ranging between 0.5m to 2.0m. Seas will deteriorate from Thursday. **Small craft operators and sea-bathers should exercise caution for above normal sea swells.** There will be no haze intrusion during this forecast period.
