Weather Discussion:

The Atlantic High pressure system will remain the dominant feature over the next few days. Fair conditions may be interrupted temporarily by sporadic brief light showers. In addition, Saharan dust haze concentration should begin to thin out along Tuesday.

Moderate to fresh (25-35km/h) easterly (E) to east south-easterly (ESE) trades will cross the islands during the next 48 hours. A reduction (~25km/h) in wind speeds is anticipated by late Thursday. Seas are currently slight to moderate (1.2m-1.8m) in open water but should become generally moderate (1.5m-2.1m) during the next two days. In addition, swell heights should decrease by Thursday evening.

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
