## Weather Discussion:

The Atlantic High Pressure System will continue to generate brisk winds and generally fair conditions across the Eastern Caribbean during the next 24 hours. Thereafter, weak instability along the southern periphery of the High Pressure System, is likely to result in occasional cloudy skies with showers.

Easterly to north-easterly winds ranging between 20 km/h to 35km/h will continue today, before decreasing to peak near 30 km/h during Friday.

Seas are moderate in open water with swells ranging from 1.5 to 2.5 meters ( 5 to 8 feet ) and decreasing. **Small-craft operators and sea bathers should continue to exercise caution.**

The layer of Saharan dust haze across the islands will gradually diminish, allowing for improved visibility and air quality.

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
