

#### Weather Discussion:

Weak unstable conditions could support occasional cloudy skies across St. Vincent and the Grenadines(SVG) by this (Tuesday) evening. A few showers could linger across SVG during Wednesday. Partly cloudy-cloudy skies are likely during Thursday, with a few scattered showers. Meanwhile, pockets of Saharan dust concentrations across our area could maintain slight haze at times.

Light-occasional moderate (10 - 20km/h) breeze across our islands could occasionally increase (25 - 30km/h) and wind directions vary from northeast to southeast in some locations.

Sea conditions are slight to moderate in open water, with swells near 1.0m west of our islands and up to 2.0m east of our islands.
