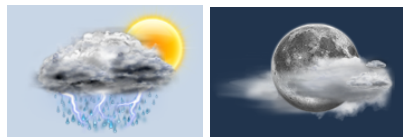




# 72 Hour Weather Outlook

## Weather Discussion:

Unstable conditions associated with tropical waves are crossing the islands, with scattered showers and thunderstorms across St. Vincent and the Grenadines (SVG)...*Residents and motorists in areas prone to flash-flooding and landslides or near rivers and streams should continue to exercise caution...*Weak unstable conditions could linger across SVG over the weekend. Fairly good visibility continues across our area, with an occasional film of haze.

Light-gentle (< 20km/h) breeze across our islands could vary from east north-easterly to south-easterly in some locations, occasionally increasing (20 - 25km/h) near showers.

Sea conditions are slight to moderate in open water, appearing smooth at times with swells near 0.5m west of our islands and ranging 0.8m - 1.5m east of our islands.

Tropical Depression Seven could become a Tropical Storm in the Eastern Atlantic Ocean. The low pressure areas a few hundred miles east of the island chain have a low (0 - 20 %) chance of development...*The St. Vincent and the Grenadines Meteorological Services will continue to monitor any developments and issue updates/advisories as necessary.*
