



Flash-Flood Watch in effect for ST. VINCENT AND THE GRENADINES

Issued at 12:00 noon, Tuesday 12th November, 2024

The Inter-tropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) is affecting the southern portion of the island chain resulting in unstable conditions across portions of Saint Vincent and the Grenadines. Showers and chance of isolated thunderstorms are possible this afternoon and due to the already saturated nature of the soil, the SVG MET Services is issuing a flash-flood watch effective 12:00 noon, Tuesday 12th November, until 6pm.

A Flood-Watch is issued when conditions are favourable and there exists the possibility of flooding during the watch period.

...Residents and motorists in areas prone to flash-flooding and landslides or near rivers and streams should be prepared...

The St Vincent and the Grenadines Meteorological Services will continue to monitor conditions and provide the necessary updates.
