Weather Discussion:

The Atlantic high pressure system will generally remain dominant across SVG during this forecast period. A few showers are likely into Monday as patches of moisture crosses our islands. Generally fair conditions are anticipated for Tuesday and Wednesday, however this may be interrupted with a few sporadic short lived showers.

Strong (~40 km/h) east south-easterly trades are crossing our islands. A slight decrease (~35 km/h) in speed is expected from Monday, decreasing (~25km/h) further by midweek. A shift to east north easterly would begin from Tuesday. Seas are moderate in open water with swells ranging between 1.8m and 2.4m. **Marine users should exercise caution for above normal sea swells.** Sea conditions should improve on Wednesday. In addition, Saharan dust haze of varying intensities will be visible across our islands within the next few days, reducing visibility and air quality.
