Weather Discussion:

Weak unstable conditions linger across our area. Therefore, occasionally cloudy skies and a few scattered showers can be expected across SVG within the next 24 hours. Relatively fair conditions are anticipated along Thursday and early Friday. A tropical wave should begin to affect our islands by Friday evening resulting in scattered light to moderate showers.

Moderate to fresh (~20-30 km/h) east south easterly to easterly trades are crossing our islands, increasing to strong (~40 km/h) by Thursday. Seas are slight to moderate in open water with swells peaking near 1.0 m on western coasts and near 1.5 m on eastern coasts. Swell heights could gradually increase during this forecast period and become generally moderate by Thursday. **Small craft operators and sea bathers should exercise caution for above normal sea swells.**

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
