Weather Discussion:

The Atlantic high pressure system is dominant across our islands as breezy conditions continue. Apart from a few early showers, Tuesday should be relatively fair. A passing shearline could generate cloudy skies early Wednesday and trigger a few afternoon showers. Wednesday is forecast to be fair to occasionally cloudy with a slight chance of a few light showers. In addition, slight Saharan dust haze concentrations should be noticeable across our islands during the next three days.

Moderate to strong (~25-40 km/h) north easterly to east north easterly trades are crossing our islands with a slight decrease (~35 km/h) expected from Wednesday. Seas are moderate to rough in open waters with swells ranging between 1.5m to 1.8m to on western coasts and near 2.7 on eastern coasts. **Only vessels capable of withstanding swells of these magnitudes should venture out. Sea-bathers are advised to stay out of the water.** Generally moderate sea conditions are forecast from midweek.
