Weather Discussion:

As patches of moisture crosses our islands, occasional cloudy skies are likely during the next three days. In addition, the presence of an upper level trough will provide some occasional support and trigger pockets of moderate showers.

Gentle to moderate (~15-25 km/h) north easterly to east north easterly trades are crossing our islands. An increase (~20-30 km/h) in speeds is likely on Monday. Seas should remain slight to moderate in open waters with swells peaking at 1.0m on the western coasts and near 1.5m on the eastern coasts. Saharan dust haze intrusion is expected on Monday reducing visibility and air quality across our islands.
