Weather Discussion:

The Atlantic high pressure system is dominant across our islands, resulting in fair conditions. The chance of showers increases along Saturday as shallow patches of moisture crosses our islands within the wind flow. Partly cloudy skies with occasional showers are anticipated on Monday.

Gentle (< 20 km/h) easterly to east south easterly trades are crossing our islands, shifting to east north easterly occasionally within the next 72 hours. Speeds will increase (15-25km/h) from Friday. Seas will remain slight to moderate in open waters with swells peaking near 1.0 m on the western coasts and ranging between 1.5m to 2.0m on the eastern coasts. No significant Saharan dust haze concentrations are anticipated during this forecast period.
