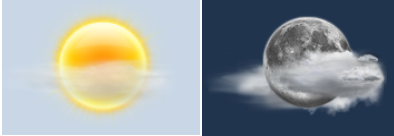

Weather Discussion:

Dry and stable conditions persist across the islands. Over the weekend, cloud patches are likely to bring a few showers across St. Vincent and the Grenadines (SVG). Meanwhile, Saharan dust concentrations create an occasional film/slight-haze across our area.

A gradual reduction in wind speeds can be expected across our islands, becoming gentle-moderate (10 - 20km/h) by Friday and wind directions could vary from east northeast to south southeast in some locations.

Sea conditions are slight to moderate in open water, with occasional northerly swells near 1.2m (4ft) west of our islands and 1.8m (6ft) east of our islands. A gradual fall in swell heights may be noticeable by Friday, ranging 0.5m (1.5ft) to 1.5m (5ft) across SVG.
