## Weather Discussion:

Cloudiness and shower activity across St. Vincent and the Grenadines (SVG) could decrease by Saturday night. Meanwhile, Saharan dust concentrations vary in intensity and create a film/slight-haze across our area.

Moderate-fresh (20 - 35km/h) breeze across our islands could vary in direction from east northeast to southeasterly in some locations. Wind speeds are likely to peak (~ 40km/h) across SVG on Saturday and return to moderate (~ 25km/h) breeze during Monday.

Sea conditions are slight to moderate in open water, with swells ranging 1.0m (3ft) to 1.5m (5ft) west of our islands and ranging 1.8m (6ft) to 2.5m (8ft) east of our islands...*Small-craft operators and sea-bathers should exercise caution for above normal swells and occasional gusty winds during Saturday and Sunday.*

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
