Weather Information Statement No. 1 for St. Vincent and the Grenadines

Issued: 8:00 am Saturday 6th September, 2025

The St. Vincent and the Grenadines Meteorological Services continues to monitor a tropical wave located in the Central Atlantic along 39° W. Although relatively dry air will limit potential tropical development of this system over the next couple of days, environmental conditions may become marginally favorable thereafter. A tropical depression could form during the early and middle part of next week as the system moves westward at around 10 mph across the central tropical Atlantic.

There is a low chance (30%) of development within the next 48 hours and a medium chance (60%) of tropical cyclone formation over the next 7 days. The system is likely to be near the Lesser Antilles by the middle to latter part of next week

Residents are advised to keep informed on the progress of this system.
